

3 Decisions That Can Greatly Affect Your Fuel Consumption Costs

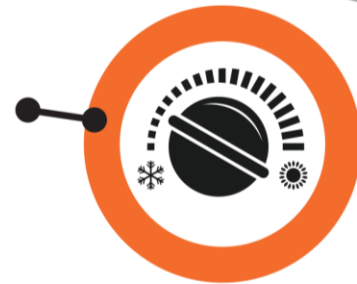
1. The type of fuel you consume
